QLearn is our Learning Management System (LMS)


- It is a tool that will be consistent across all of your subjects

Choice 1: BYOD

• Bring your own device which is a Windows 11 Device (Windows 10 is sufficient and will work)

Choice 2: Laptop4Rent

• You can rent a laptop from our school





BYOD Choices

1.1: Purchase from any retailer or provide one you already have at home

- The school cannot help with warranty claims
- If device fails, please talk with your retail provider

1.2: Purchase from Forest Lake SHS BYOD Portal

- Purchase from the FLSHS website with confidence
- IT Helpdesk will log all warranty and support claims for you
- We recommend you purchase Accidental Damage Protection (ADP)



BYOD Choices

- 2: Laptop4Rent is owned and rented to you by Forest Lake State High School
 - Owned and managed by our school
 - Warranty and ADP included in the rental price
 - Software managed by the school
 - Limited rights to install software on the Laptop
 - No administration rights
 - School retains ownership
 - Handed back to school at the end of each year



Accidental Damage Protection (ADP)

BYOD ADP

- A must in schools
- School use is very different to home use
- Claim prices vary from between companies so please read terms and agreement for BYOD

Laptop4Rent ADP

- 1st claim = \$100
- 2nd claim = \$200 or cost of repair (whichever is cheaper)
- Subsequent claims = cost of repair



Software

- Do not buy any additional software
- Virus protection is already inbuilt into the Windows 11 operating system
- Do not buy McAfee or other software as it often causes firewall issues on our school network and we uninstall it to enable devices to work
- All Microsoft Products are provided free
- All Adobe Products are provide as a component of Student Resource Scheme (SRS)



BYOD Considerations

- Active Pen input
- Light weight for carrying to school
- Must be 5GHz wireless, Windows 10/11 Laptop
- Robust design school vs. home use
- Carry case to offer protection
- Battery life will it last the school day?
- Warranty length, repair location (back to base) and repair times
- Accidental Damage Protection
- Insurance against loss or theft



Summary: Technology Choices

Bring Your Own Device (BYOD)

- Student Owned
 - Warranty via retail provider
 - At your cost
- Purchase from School Portal
 - Warranty and support via school
 - At your cost
- Laptop for Rent (Laptop4Rent)
 - Warranty, support and software managed by school
 - \$350 per year (for 2024)
