



FLAKER DREAM MURAL/ARTWORK TENDER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Forest Lake State High School invites artists to submit a tender for a project plan to design and create a mural/artwork to depict the FLAKER DREAM – our reconciliation vision for future generations. It is envisaged that the design and production will include school students and staff.

The mural is to be painted/displayed on a wall at the entrance of the school with the dimensions of approximately 12.5m x 1.5m (see image).

The mural could depict a range of messages including:

- Respect for the First Nation peoples of the area;
- the harmony of cultural diversity within our school community;
- the connections to our local cultures and heritage;
- the building of relationships with our local Indigenous community and.
- symbolism and/or stories from the Jagera, Yuggera and Ugarapul people.

The Project Plan should include:

- processes to design and create the mural;
- resources required of the school to undertake the project;
- timelines for each stage of the process;
- details of costings.

The selected artist will create a storyboard that will outline the features within the mural and the overall messages of the FLAKER DREAM.

Artists should submit a portfolio of their previous works/collaborations as part of the tender.

It is a requirement to hold a current Blue Card to work with children and young people.
