The following information is provided to assist your planning for the 2024 school year.

1 Starting date for students in 2024:

ALL year levels 7 - 12 commence 8:30am Monday 22 January 2024

Year 7 Students assemble in the Hall

Year 8 Students assemble Year 8 under cover area behind Roycroft Year 9 Students assemble Year 9 under cover area behind Sauvage

Years 10,11 &12 Students will attend extended roll classes. Check roll class lists for classrooms:

Years10 & 11 – Lists in Senior Courtyard; Year 12 – Lists at LRC entrance

Formal school uniform must be worn by ALL students on first day of attendance.

2 School Office

The school office will be closed for the period Monday 11 December 2023 to Monday 15 January 2024 (inclusive), reopening on Tuesday 16 January 2024.

The payment window will close for 2023 at 1:00pm on **Wednesday 6 December 2023**, reopening for payments from 8:30am on Tuesday 16 January 2024.

Office hours for the week 16 - 19 January 2024 will be 8:30am – 3:30pm daily. EFTPOS and credit card facilities will be available for those wishing to pay the 2024 student resource scheme which is due for payment or part payment prior to Monday 22 January 2024. For existing students, invoices can be paid at any time using the BPOINT link at the bottom left of any invoice or statement issued by FLSHS.

Please note: We are unable to issue invoices for our new year 7 students until approximately week 3 of first term, however we ask that payment be made in person at the payment window after the school opens again on Tuesday 16 January 2024.

Normal office hours of 8:00am - 4:00pm will resume on Monday 22 January 2024.

3 Student Resource Scheme - 2024

The Forest Lake SHS Student Resource Scheme ensures that all students have the necessary resources for their education. Participation in the Scheme saves parents/carers money and the need to shop for school books and other necessary resources. (Parents should be aware that in years 7, 8 and 9, many curriculum related resources made available to students may be in the form of school-produced booklets. These are chosen in preference to textbooks as they better support the Australian Curriculum and State based curriculum). *Information regarding "BYOD"* (*Bring Your Own Computer Device*) *in 2024 can be found on the school website*.

The FLSHS Parents and Citizens' Association endorsed the following Student Resource Scheme costs for 2024.

It is a requirement that all parents wishing to participate in the Student Resource Scheme complete the "Participation Agreement Form". Previously this form was issued and completed yearly. Education Queensland has now authorised this form to cover all school years, with the exception of changes each year to the fees for each year level. If you have not completed and returned a Participation Agreement Form previously, please contact the school office. It is a requirement of Education Queensland that Resource Fees be paid over a three term period, therefore all fees for the year need to be paid by the second week of third term.

So that students may commence the new year with correct resources, payment of at least the first term's instalment by no later than the commencement of the school year i.e. Monday 22 January 2024 would be appreciated. Students will be unable to access resources until at least this minimum payment has been received.

Debtor Statement for 2024

A Statement will either be emailed or posted home. Payments will be accepted from 8:30am Tuesday 16 January 2024. Any outstanding amounts from previous years are included on the Statement. If you have already paid the Student Resource Scheme, thank you and please disregard this information.

Maintaining up to date student records is always problematic in a large school. Can you please ensure you advise the school office immediately of any changes in personal circumstances, address and/or contact details. This is particularly important at times of medical emergencies.

It would also be appreciated if you could advise the school if your son/daughter is not intending to return to Forest Lake SHS for the commencement of the 2024 school year. Because State schools are funded on enrolment numbers on day 8 of the school year Thursday, 1 February 2023), it is important that we be advised of:

- exiting students: we need to know the reason students are leaving (transferring to another school, got a job etc)
- late returns: students who are returning to FLSHS but will not return until after 1 February 2024. In this instance, we require information and documentation explaining the reasons for their late return. This could include a copy of airline tickets. Late returns could impact on students accessing preferred elective studies if the school is not formally notified.
- 5 Unless otherwise advised, the Forest Lake SHS Parents and Citizens' Association meets the 4th Tuesday of every month (during school terms). Meeting dates and the location for the meetings will be communicated in newsletters, on our website and via our electronic noticeboard on Forest Lake Boulevard.
