Forest Lake State High School will receive**

586 000*

This funding will be used to

- Improve PAT/R reading scores by an average of 4 points for students in years 7, 8 and 9 through the Forest Lake Reading Project, ensure 100% year 7 and 9 students reach NMS in Reading and Numeracy.
- Maintain the schools 100% QCE attainment.
- Improve attendance rate of students – target of 90% attendance for all students across the school.
- Deliver quality Lighthouse, Innovate and Aspiring Athletes programs to engage extension students to improve U2B results.

Our initiatives include

- Continuation of the Forest Lake Reading Project.
- Employment of support workers to increase school engagement in the senior school and support students with social and emotional issues which are a barrier to successful QCE completion
- Deliver extension programs to engage high performing students.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Employ HOD – Junior Secondary - Teaching and Learning	128 000
• Employ two teachers to provide HOD planning and observations time	200 000
• Employ teacher aides to provide: support in classrooms (120 000), Reading Program (8 000), Social/Emotional (16200)	142 200
• NAPLAN preparations – printing costs and marking	5 500
• Employ part time tutors for after-school sessions	5 800
• Senior Schooling – Teacher support (60 000) and Attendance Officer (44 500)	104 500
